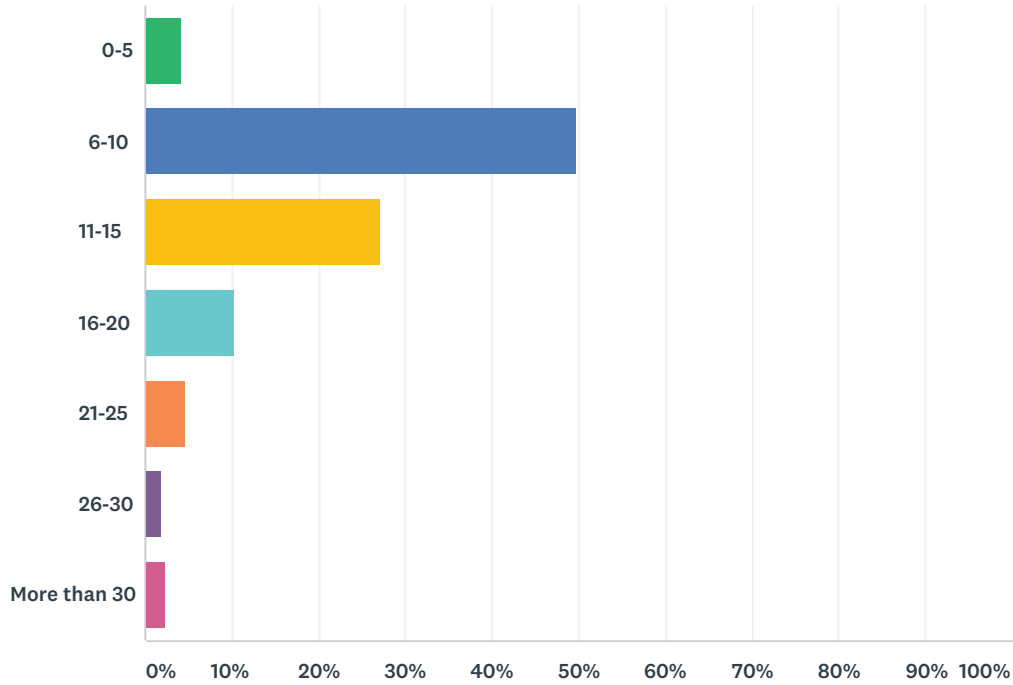


Q1 How many new records do you review per day?

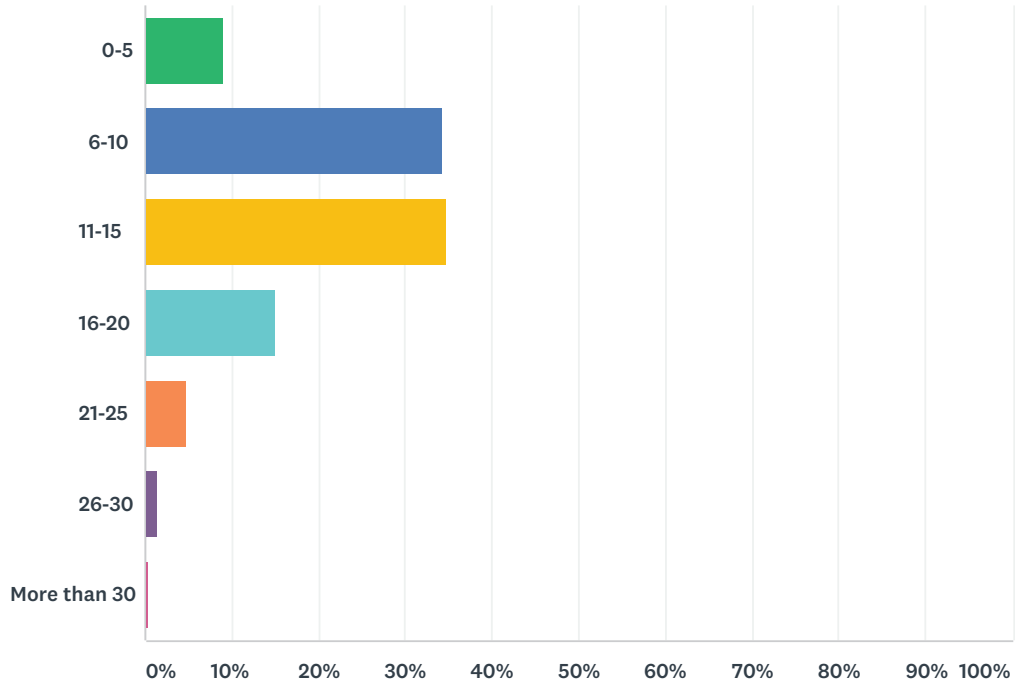

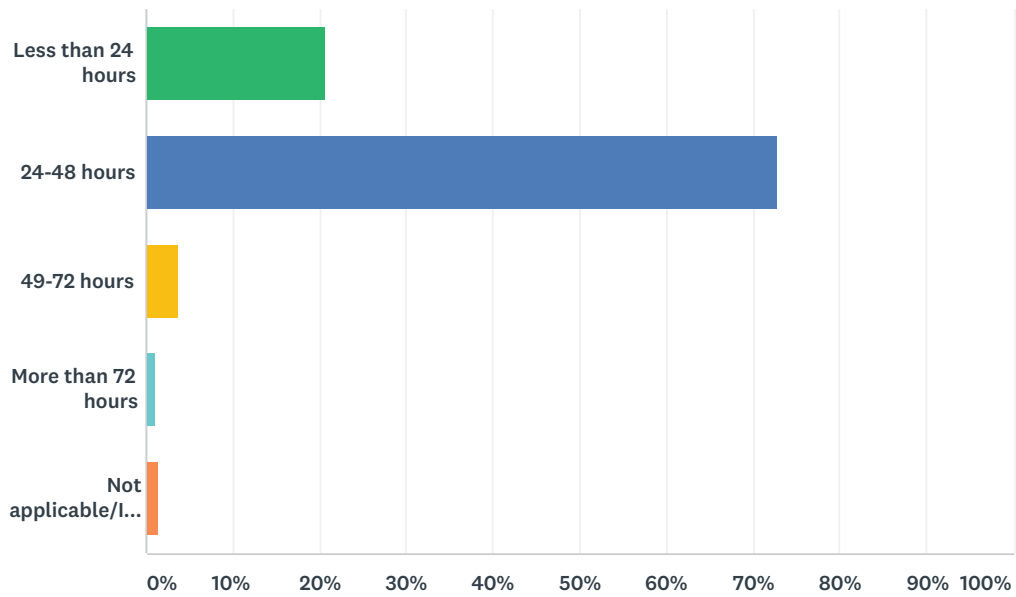

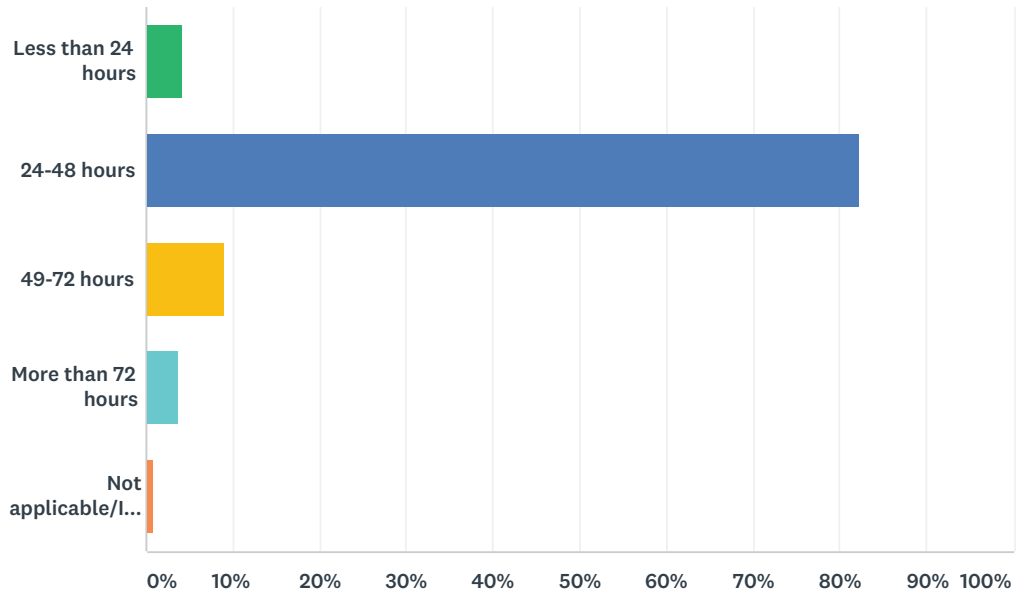

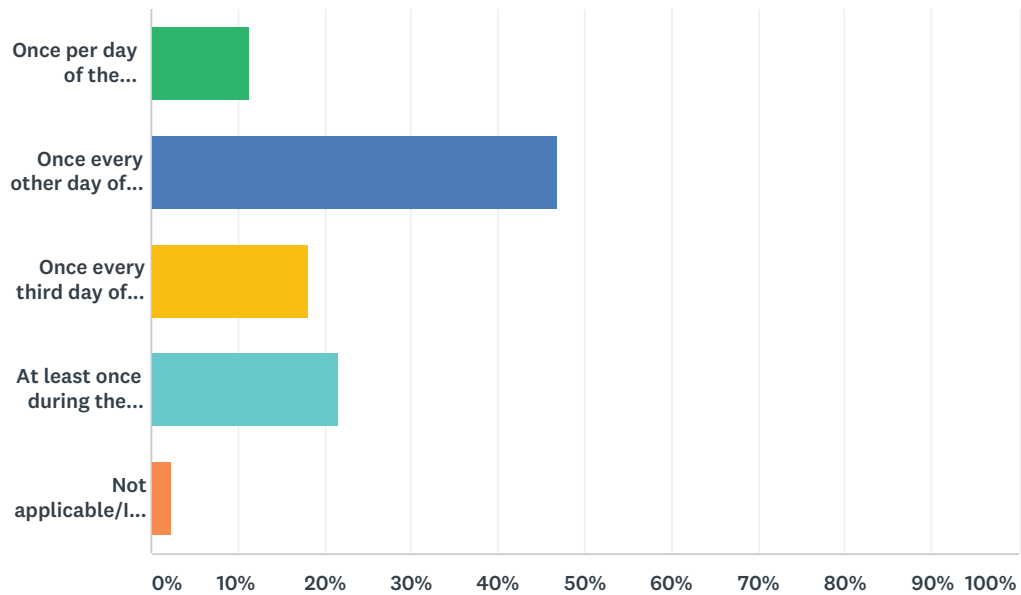
