Jennifer Pina BSN, RN, CCDS, is a Sr. CDI Specialist at CHI St. Luke's with 13 years of CDI experience.


Koko Williams MSN, RN, CMSRN, is a CDI Specialist at Cook Children's Medical Center with 4 years of CDI experience.

Save the Date for our next webinar that will be held **Tuesday, November 3, 2020**. Our presenter will be **Timothy N. Brundage, MD, CCDS** who will be discussing **"HAC's & PSI's...what's all the confusion about?"**

Dr. Timothy Brundage is Chief Executive Officer and Medical Director of Brundage Group. He is a past board member of the Association of Clinical Documentation Integrity Specialists (ACDIS) and is co-chair of the CDI Committee for the American College of Physician Advisors (ACPA).

Dr. Brundage received his BS in Chemical & Cellular Molecular Biology from the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, Michigan. He went on to obtain his Internal Medicine Residency from the University of South Florida in Tampa, Florida. He earned his MD from Wayne State University School of Medicine in Detroit, Michigan.

Dr. Brundage travels the county educating physicians, with a focus on breaking down departmental silos in hospital organizations by unifying clinical documentation across quality, utilization, denials and CDI.
