With the success of the CDI program, she was awarded the Department of the Year Award.

Committed to advancement of documentation integrity, Wendy served as a member of the ACDIS Advisory Board for the 2014-2017 term and as an Adjunct Instructor for the AHIMA CDI Academies. Wendy was also the recipient of the 2009 ACDIS Award for Recognition for Professional Achievement.
