



# Knights of the CDI Round Table

## IDEAS FOR CELEBRATING CDI WEEK 2026

- In line with this year's theme, "Knights of the CDI Round Table," leaders can conduct a knighting ceremony for each team member with a literal or metaphorical CDI sword prop and/or award them a crest, such as "Best Scribe," "Query Queen/King," "Review Slayer," "Dragon Tamer," and "Savvy Squire."
- Have an informal meeting with your team on Monday, September 14, to kick off CDI Week. Share a "Who's Who at the Round Table" document highlighting each member.
- Plan a get-to-know-you game with team members, such as a BINGO card to find other team members who can fulfill each square (titled, "QUEST"), or "The Traitor at the Round Table," where everyone shares two truths and a lie.
- Send out the CDI Week word find and crossword puzzle (posted the week before CDI Week on [acdis.org](https://www.acdis.org)), then have a contest so that whoever completes it first receives a prize.
- Organize a virtual or in-person dragon egg hunt, searching for things such as codes, tip cards and other CDI resources, or what *Coding Clinic* addresses a scenario.
- If there are multiple CDI teams at your organization, hold a team photo contest and have each team give itself a fantasy-themed name and slogan. Share and have everyone vote on their favorite.
- Share a CDI-themed riddle every day with your team; count up who got the most right at the end of the week and award them a crown.
- Create fantasy-themed educational resources such as "How to tame your dragon" for engaging providers or "Slaying AI dragons" for combating AI hallucinations.
- Create a Mad-Lib of a provider's note about a diagnosis and/or a query letter for your team to fill out; have everyone share their different versions and enjoy a few laughs.
- Send out a "kingdom scroll" each day highlighting a team member and their accomplishments.
- If you have a hospital newsletter, be sure to ask for CDI Week to be mentioned in it. Explain what CDI is, highlight the team members, and share a little bit about what you all do.
- If you have a landing page for hospital use, see if you can put a banner there for CDI Week so everyone working will know about the week of celebration.
