Indy is located in the center of the "Path of Totality": We'll experience a total solar eclipse for 3 minutes and 46 seconds

Eclipse occurs during registration time—before opening reception begins at 4:00 p.m.

Eclipse glasses available at the registration desk (sponsored by Iodine) Step outside from the registration area into the ACDIS open-air spot, perfect to view the eclipse

 - Expansion topics including beginning outpatient CDI, and high- and low-tech CDI solutions






Keynotes


